



ASRF COMPLIANCE RULES FOR GO-WHOA EVENTS



(Applicable to all States & Territories at any ASRF Sanctioned Event)

- Appropriate vehicle impact absorbing barriers to be installed on both sides of the go-whoa track (e.g. concrete or water filled interlocking drums)
- Spectators to be retained behind a physical delineation line or fence positioned not less than 10mtrs distance from the track barriers.
- Go-whoa track must be of a sealed surface and not loose.
- A public 'No Go Exclusion Zone' to be created and controlled at either end of the track. Extending a minimum of 25mtrs behind the start line and a minimum of 40mtrs after the finish line. These areas should be delineated for public vision.
- Only one vehicle to participate at any one time.
- A minimum of 4 designated ASRF members to supervise the event and maintain spectator compliance to security and safety provisions. Such personnel to wear garments to clearly identify their status.
- All participants must be current financial members of the ASRF.
- All entrants must produce a .000 alcohol reading to be recorded immediately prior to the commencement of the event.
- All participants must be a minimum age of 17 and hold a current drivers licence.
- All drivers must sign a 'Hold Harmless/Disclaimer Agreement' prior to participating.
- Go-whoa event must have the official sanction of the ASRF.
- Authority and approvals must be obtained from all relevant and necessary authorities including Police, Local Council & Government Authorities or Departments.
- A 'Safety Management Plan' must be prepared and distributed to all personnel in charge of the event.
- A 'Traffic Management Plan' must be prepared if deemed necessary.

Non compliance to any of these rules, could result in cancellation of ASRF Sanction &/or Public Liability Coverage without notice.
