Incoming Correspondence

- Dave Clift had a State Directors phone hookup last week.
- Sanction Forms A & B now available on the website. It includes details required by the ASRF Insurance company.

- ASRF Raffle car is being reconsidered in a different format. Will not travel all around Australia due to cost.

- ASRF Honour Role and Hall of Fame to start with 5 names and added to annually. Robert Riggs And Dave to work on this this week.

- Email received from “Top End Rumble” which is a pre ’65 run. Organiser is an ASRF Member based in the North Territory so event comes under the jurisdiction of South Aust ASRF. Organisers wants 3 sanctions for venues between Darwin to Alice Springs: one needed cover for a grass driving karna event – slow and safe; Show and Sine at Katherine Showgrounds & possible for a stop between Katherine and Alice Springs. NCC will review when Sanction application is put through
- Newcastle Hot Rod Nationals law suit has been settled out of court. Terms of settlement are confidential. Matter is now finalised.
- ASRF has 11 different insurance policies. Insurance premiums are under review after reasonable period of stability. The main one being Public Liability costing approx \$64,000pa; Policies cover ASRF members and their spouses and junior rodders in regard to a workshop events and the usual equipment, Head Office workers comp etc.
- Aust Street Rod Nationals at Maryborough Qld event is progressing well. Entry number are a little down on expectation for this time prior to event. Discussion on distance – Google indicates Sydney to Maryborough is 1230km in 14hr via New England or 1180km in 12 .5 hours via Pacific Hwy. However much longer when necessary stops taken into account
- Get well soon card sent to Adrian Buckley who is back in hospital again.
- Ray Mason and Dave Clift have arranged 2 pull up banners to promote the 2021 Albury Nationals. These will be used in displays at the Maryborough Nationals on a combined stand with the ACT Director AL Cooper in Easter 2019.
- Entry Forms are available for Easter in the Hawkesbury run. Deposit has been paid for the venue and activities are being finalised for day trips including wine tasting at the showground.

Kar Nutz: Cars Under the Stars:

Barney advised that the following event had been rained out:

However the Penrith Homemaker Centre did proceed with 190 cars. Very Successful

Meeting held with Penrith Homemaker Centre Management and decision made to accumulate funds for 3 months and make one large donation in lieu of smaller monthly donations. \$2300 from last show is allocated for donation to a yet to be decided Charity.

DamFest - 21st Oct: The Chariots held a Swap Meet in the Morning. Overcast day but no rain. 126 cars entered and 92 were judged. 26 Bikes and 12 were judged. Attendance by the public to the event was enormous The Neighbourhood Centre at Warragamba raised approximate \$18,000. The Chariot Club donated \$430 for Down Syndrome.

Wiseman Ferry Mens Shed - 21st Oct: Not a lot in attendance - about 50 cars. The Town Mayor attended.

ChromeFest - 26-28 Oct

ASRF provided sponsorship and had an ASRF Trade Stand. Kar Nutz club donated cost of stand. Great exposure for ASRF and answered lots of questions. Sold 2.5 books of raffle tickets. 68 Low riders; Retro Caravans; 80 Trade Stands, countless cars. About 40,000 people attended. Big budget event mainly via local council who organise a lot of the infrastructure (road closures, security, big marquee and dance floor etc) made for a successful show. Next year you will be able to enter onto the grass up to 10am in lieu of 7am and leave after 3pm. OH&S issued.
