Business Arising from previous Newsletter

The ASRF NCC had the AGM on a 4 hour zoom Conference on Saturday morning 19/Sept/2020 commencing at 9.00am. The Minutes are attached for your information. ASRF Accountant Phil McKee and Gavin Kelso were also on the Conference call.

To put the financials in a nut shell they are as follows;

*The ASRF lost \$9,918.00 over the last 12 months due to the cancellation of events and Covid restrictions.

*The ASRF currently has \$1,419,646.00 dollars net in cash and assets of which \$404,192 is in the 2 buildings we own in Qld and Vic. This includes H/O equipment, investments and State DC funds.

* This of course is the off year without a Numbered Nationals and the 3 larger states membership renewal is next year. As you can see, we have survived the Covid so far, a lot better than many other organisations.
