## **General Business**

The ASRF as an organisation is a member of the Australian Automotive Aftermarket Association. In their latest magazine issue, it has been exposed that a state of Aus. wanted to cease registering vehicles after 2035 that had Internal Combustion engines.

I have spoken to Lesley Yates of the AAAA and she has informed me that it was the state of Victoria that was attempting to implicate this. They also wanted to introduce a 2-2.5 cents/Kilometre tax on all electric vehicles. Reason being that they would not pay fuel tax.

I am happy to inform you all that the Vic. Government has now squashed this idea after pressure from the AAAA.

### **\*ASRF NSW Constitution**

The ASRF is undergoing some changes and will become a Limited Company under Guarantee. The organisation will not change structure on the outside.

The NCC has decided to adopt the WA Rules/Constitution as Guide Lines for each state to use as a Discussion paper. I have asked both Bob Milburn (Northern Beaches) and Gary Stanley (Rattlers) to review the WA Constitution and get back to me.
